



Vale Teresa 'Terry' Archer


28/11/1931 - 23/06/2024

Magic Moments Bucket List - Living your best life and Positive Aging



The sequel to the International Number One Bestseller The Tattooist of Auschwitz, based on a true story of love and resilience. Cilka is just sixteen years old when she is taken to Auschwitz-Birkenau Concentration Camp, in 1942.
